1. **Welcome, introduction and apologies-** Welcome Louise and Jennifer (CoF) planning and Andrew (CC) consultant engaged by HA and CoF for the redevelopment.
2. **Minutes of meeting 25 November 2016-**accepted as an accurate record of the meeting. K Seery
3. **Business Arising**
 - a. Pascal reported that the quote for the gazebo has been received and construction should commence shortly. The design specifications included capacity to relocate the structure given the redevelopment plan.
 - b. Pascal is waiting for confirmation of a budget for the community arts project that will produce the park sign. It was suggested that the residents who the research and history of DP be involved in the project where possible. Pascal to circulate the history document that was produced by the residents.
 - c. Judy mentioned the base line data collection and the recent review conducted around the livability of DP. **ACTION: Report to be provided to Andrew.** andrew@creatingcommunities.com.au

- d. Redevelopment & Community Consultation Process-Louise outline the process from CoF perspective. Currently a Master Plan is being developed. Creating Communities have been jointly engaged by CoF and HA to facilitate the process. Louise provided a number of examples to illustrate the process of developing a master plan such as identification of services that may include police and fire station, community open space, meeting the needs of young people and the aging population of the area.
- e. Creating communities has been tasked with defining the vision. Andrew indicated this would involve an holistic approach, engaging community & key stakeholders to determine:
 - What will it look like?
 - What is required? andEngaging people in the conversations to develop an integrated plan. Community consultation would be broader than just DP residents.
- e. A mix of housing is planned including social, low cost and public ownership with an increased density across the whole development.
- f. Louise is revising the FAQ on the website and questions which other agencies are receiving from residents should be emailed direct to louisea@fremantle.wa.gov.au to help reflect what people want to know. Other useful information would include an indicative timeline.
- g. Discussion highlighted the cohesiveness of the community in DP and the need to protect and consider the "community" aspect in the planning process. Many of the residents have lived in the area for more than 25 years. **ACTION: Julie to provide demographics.**
- h. Events in the park have been used as a platform to seek community input, gather data such as the base line survey and the park redevelopment. CC is keen to link with existing activities to engage with the community. An attempt will be made to align the next Family Fun Market with the opening of the gazebo. This event will provide an opportunity for Andrew to engage with the residents and surrounding community members.
ACTION: Pascal to advise gazebo date of completion asap. Kate will try to align the April market day.
